

DAYLILLY ALERT on RUST

Rust on Daylilies is very contagious to other daylilies. Can kill your hybrid varieties very quickly.

Preventative maintenance :

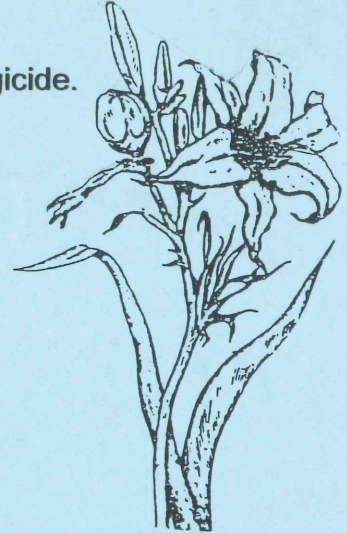
Spray once a month with Dithane M-45, Thiomyl or Bayleton Systemic Fungicide. Commercial growers use Hertiage or Banner-Max that is very expensive because you can only buy it in large quantities, not small sizes. Dithane M-45, Thiomyl and Bayleton will do just as good.

Curative maintenance:

If spots of red dots, looks like rusty appearance on the foliage.

1. Prune infected leaves down to the ground.
2. Dip clippers in a bleach water solution (2 Tbsp. per gallon of water) as you trim the infected leaves.
3. Clean out any dead foliage that is on the ground around the daylily.
4. Throw away all leaves and debris in a plastic bag and tie it up.
DO NOT put the leaves in a compost pile.
5. Spray weekly to protect and prevent the new growth.

Spray at least 3 times, 7-10 days apart.
